



Fairfax County Fire Prevention Permits Requirements

Effective July 1, 2006, Fairfax County Fire Prevention Code will require a Permit License and Filing fee for any events, shows or participating exhibitors that displays any of the following:

- Propane Burners (i.e.: Fire Place Demonstrations, Cooking demonstrations); This includes one or more exhibitors with fireplace demonstrations, Propane burner, etc...Please inform DECC at least two weeks prior to the event if any of the above will be displayed at the show. This will allow enough time to obtain the permit required prior to the event. One permit will cover the entire show. If the show is in both buildings then one permit for each building is required. The fee for this permit is \$200.00 and is valid for the duration of the show. Again, please inform DECC at least two weeks prior to your event if a permit is required for your show.
- Jewelry Repair / Hot Work / welding, etc... Please inform DECC of Each Exhibitor demonstrating, displaying or performing any jewelry repair / Hot Work or welding. Each exhibitor will need to submit an application for a permit along with full payment at least two weeks prior to the show, so we may obtain a License Permit. The fee for each permit is \$100.00. Once a Permit is obtained from Fairfax County, a final inspection by the Fire Marshall will occur prior to show opening.
- Vehicle Permit: Fee is \$200.00 for each building that will have at least one or more displayed vehicles during the show. Once a Permit is obtained from Fairfax County, a final inspection by the Fire Marshall will occur prior to show opening.

Please note that Lit Candles are NO Longer allowed at Dulles Expo Center, No Exceptions.
